Our podiatry team is committed to providing comprehensive care for foot and ankle conditions. Services offered are diabetic foot exams, removal of corns and calluses, cutting of the nails, foot pain, fungal in the nails, ingrown toenails, and assess, diagnose, treat, and manage conditions of the feet and legs.



#### Radiology

Our top priority at the Radiology Department is to improve patient care by providing high quality services with state of the art advanced X-Ray machines, ultrasound machines, and dexa bone density equipment for different parts of the body.

#### **Healthcare Hero**

At New Horizon Health Center, the commitment to providing compassionate and accessible care is embodied by healthcare professionals like Esmeralda Roque, a dedicated Physician Assistant specializing in adult medicine. Coming from a low-income family, she experienced firsthand the need for accessible healthcare. This fueled her lifelong dream of becoming a medical professional and addressing the struggles she witnessed growing up in the Rio Grande Valley, where families often faced months-long wait for medical care.

Esmeralda's path to becoming a PA was marked by hard work and perseverance. She graduated high school in 2015 and earned a Pharmacy Technician certification, and worked as a technician for eight years while pursuing her undergraduate degree in Biology with a minor in Chemistry at the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV). She then completed her Physician Assistant training at UTRGV, graduating in 2023. Being a pharmacy technician allowed her finance her education.

Now, as a provider, Esmeralda is a tireless advocate for her patients, particularly those who are low-income or uninsured. She strives to ensure they receive the care they need by leveraging resources available at the health center or finding creative solutions, such as locating coupons for medications or coordinating specialist appointments before a patient leaves. Her philosophy of care is rooted in empathy, treating each patient as she would want her own parents to be treated.

Working closely with patients dealing with chronic conditions such as hypertension, diabetes, and high cholesterol, she provides medical care and emphasizes the importance of patient education. Whether it's guiding patients on nutrition, teaching them how to properly administer and store medications, or connecting them with the center's in-house dietitian, Esmeralda goes above and beyond to ensure her patients feel supported and informed.

Reflecting on her journey, Esmeralda shared, "It felt right to come back as a provider instead of a patient." Her dedication and compassionate care continue to make a significant impact on the lives of the patients she serves, furthering the mission of New Horizon Health Center, and that is why she is our Healthcare Hero.





### **Patient Story**

Julie Jaramillo came to New Horizon Health Center after feeling exhausted from traveling outside of Brownsville, sometimes outside of Cameron County and Texas, just to be seen by a doctor. Not only was it taking a toll on her health, but also her mental health.

While traveling far and wide to find quality care, Julie was also recovering from open heart surgery, where her doctors gave her a diagnosis of "not having a long time left to live." Frustrated with her diagnosis, travel time to be seen, and and tired of feeling severe pain, she decided to come try New Horizon Health Center.

From the moment she walked into the clinic lobby, she felt like staff really cared about her wellbeing. "It's the little things staff was offering on top of quality care, whether it be offering me a seat, asking how I'm feeling, and if I needed water. I encountered something that I never thought would happen in my life, meeting people who care, who have heart, even though they didn't know me."

In Julie's personal life, she is a psychologist and often recommends her patients to come be seen by New Horizon Health Center physicians. She says she sees a lot of sick people in Brownsville, and the community needs compassionate doctors like New Horizon Health Center has.

Julie says often the staff will see she has very good insurance and ask why she comes to New Horizon when she could go anywhere, and her response is always that she has never met more empathetic staff who cares about every single patient as much as New Horizon does.

# **Community Impact**

#### ¡Vive Tu Vida! Get Up! Get Moving!

New Horizon Health Center partnered with National Alliance for Hispanic Health and Healthy Americas Foundation to host ¡Vive Tu Vida! Get Up! Get Moving! at the Gladys Porter Zoo. This event has been going on for 18 years and is the nation's premier annual Hispanic family physical activity and healthy lifestyle event for the whole family. 10 different health agencies and 23 sponsors, we were able to give health screenings to start better health and wellbeing together.

Families enjoyed a day of fun including live music, physical activities such as Zumba, free health screenings, COVID-19 and flu vaccinations, and referrals to community health services and programs.

This year's ¡Vive Tu Vida! Get Up! Get Moving! had a record number of turn-out, with 2288 adults in attendance and 1762 children, totaling over 4,000 attendees. Of these attendees, New Horizon Health Center is excited to highlight the participation of participants making steps to a healthier lifestyle:

- 33 COVID-19 and flu vaccinations
- 73 Zumba participants
- 2500 participants in Healthy Foods activities
- 40 scheduled follow-up appointments made

The best way to treat cancer is early detection, so that is why NHHC partnered with Cologuard, which allows patients to do at-home colorectal cancer screenings with their kits, making early detection easier and more affordable for patients.



#### **Genetic Testing With Labcorp**

Genetic testing is expensive with or without insurance. NHHC partnered with Labcorp to offer genetic testing for pregnant woman to enhance prenatal care with early detection of potential genetic disorders.
